### Trauma Program Director

Located throughout the Charlotte, NC area, Carolinas HealthCare System (CHS) is a premier, multi-faceted healthcare organization whose facilities make up one of the largest integrated healthcare systems in the US.

An extraordinary leadership opportunity exists for a seasoned trauma RN to administer all aspects of adult and pediatric programs throughout our local and regional area. This highly visible position focuses on supporting programs which promote optimal quality of care within the context of the American College of Surgeons Optimal Care Guidelines, NC Trauma Guidelines, JCAHO Standards, and internal trauma policies and procedures for clinical and financial performance.

Local responsibilities include: completing RFPs and coordinating site team visits for verification as a Level I Trauma Center by the NC Office of EMS and the American College of Surgeons; strategic planning and personnel management including oversight responsibilities for Trauma Registry, Trauma Process Improvement Program (TPIP) and personnel; and mid level provider program for Trauma/SCC. Additional responsibilities include coordination of local/regional professional continuing education for healthcare professionals; oversight of the CHS trauma website; and establishes CHS as a regional resource center for trauma related issues.

Regional responsibilities include: ongoing development and evaluation of our regional trauma system – the Metrolina Trauma Advisory Committee (M-TAC) to include distribution of public information/education related to trauma and injury prevention; trauma system guidelines/transfer agreements; development of RAC plan for organizational structure and bylaws; management of regional Process Improvement Program.

Qualified candidates must possess current NC RN license with a Master's degree. Three years of direct or indirect clinical trauma care experience at a nationally recognized Level I Trauma Center required. Must have demonstrated competencies (prehospital, aeromedical program, acute trauma care) and excellent computer, analytical and organizational skills.
