



## Nursing Director Trauma Program

*Duties will include:*

- Collaborating with Scott & White leadership, medical staff and nursing staff as well as the Texas Department of Health, Central Texas Regional Advisory Council and the American College of Surgeons Committee on Trauma regarding verification criteria, regulatory compliance, and continuous survey readiness.
- Reporting ongoing performance improvement initiatives, identifying deficiencies and providing corrective actions.
- Ensuring corporate compliance, performs annual reviews, recruitment/retention and professional development of staff

Strong public relation skills will be needed as you lead the marketing/public relations initiatives for the Scott & White image campaign. You'll represent the Trauma Program on various hospital and community committees; provide support for philanthropic/fundraising initiatives; and attend local, state and national nursing and trauma conferences. You will also be responsible for co-chairing the Annual Trauma Symposium and participating in development of trauma care systems at the local, regional and state level.

***Requirements:*** Five years experience; BSN; TX BNE licensure or temporary permit; and current ACLS, ATCN and TNCC certifications. Competency in nursing management and skills in interpersonal relationships (including conflict resolution) are vital for this high-profile leadership position.
