



NEUROSURGERY TRAUMA/PRACTICE POSITION

Frankford Hospital is a 486 bed tertiary care medical center, with three acute care hospitals including Frankford Campus (120 beds), Torresdale Campus (249 beds) and Bucks Campus (117 beds). In response to an increasing patient volume, Torresdale is currently undergoing an expansion that includes the addition of 51 new acute-care beds. Torresdale houses 13 dedicated neurosurgery beds and a 24-bed ultra-modern ICU. A stable nursing staff, a loyal group of primary referring physicians and strong radiology and anesthesia departments support all three locations.

Frankford Hospital is financially successful due in part to a dense patient population with a reasonable payer mix. In the past two years \$1 million in neurosurgery equipment has been purchased including a Stealth Navigational System, an OEC- 9800 C-Arm with neurosurgery package, and new instrumentation for cranial and complex spine procedures. We also have a sophisticated teleradiography program, enabling on-call physicians to conveniently view all images regardless of modality from home.

Our hospital is situated in the Northeast quadrant of the greater Philadelphia metropolitan area. We are located in Bucks County, and many of our physicians live in that area. It is an attractive area with strong school systems, enriched by 300 years of history, 600,000 residents, and many towns, villages, and neighborhoods that enjoy a robust quality of life. We are conveniently located close to major airports and cultural centers.
