### Coordinator Trauma Registry

Immediate full-time position available in Clinical Data Services at Legacy Emanuel Hospital & Health Center, a level 1 Trauma Center. The Trauma Registry Coordinator is responsible for the management, analysis and reporting of data from the Trauma Registry. This role also Designs and evaluates information reports, organizes data into usable information and prepares projections and targets from available data. Acts as an interface between system users and Information Services. This position also acts as a Contact person for the State of Oregon Trauma Registry and the National Trauma Data Base.

A Bachelor's degree in a health related field or AHIMA approved program required. Certified Trauma Registrar (CTR) required within one year of hire.

Three to five years progressive work experience with data and databases, with ability to retrieve, organize and present data using computer database

applications or related software required. Experience in a health-related environment preferred. RHIA, RHIT, CCS or other equivalent certifications preferred.
