Data is entered into the pre-defined database to ensure the hospital remains compliant with all standards as they relate to Joint Commission, American College of Surgeons (ACOS), National Trauma Database (NTDB) and the State of Oregon.

This position requires Successful completion of AHIMA approved program or college degree in a health related field. Three years inpatient ICD-9 coding and/or Abbreviated Injury Scale (AIS) coding and trauma registry abstracting preferred. Certified Trauma Registrar preferred or certification completed 1 year from hire. RHIA, RHIT, CCS or other equivalent certification preferred.
