The Trauma Nurse Clinician under the supervision of the Emergency/Trauma Services Manager will assist with coordination of the care of trauma patients and data abstraction. Collaborate with physicians; consultants and multi-disciplinary trauma team members to assure quality patient outcomes across the continuum of care through promotion of trauma standards of care according to nationally accepted guidelines.

This position is responsible for the overall coordination of the Trauma Prevention Program, the objective of which is to coordinate activities that will educate the Aurora BayCare Medical Center staff and the community about trauma prevention. Develops and coordinates all trauma projects involving pediatric, adolescents and adults. Provides technical assistance to schools, communities and other outreach areas.

Qualifications include current licensure as a Registered Nurse (RN) granted by the State of Wisconsin. Bachelor's degree in Nursing (BSN); Master's degree in Nursing preferred. Current Certification in Emergency Nursing (CEN) granted by Emergency Nurses Association OR in Critical Care Nursing (CCRN) granted by Association of Critical Care Nurses OR in Flight Nursing (CFRN) granted by Emergency Nurses Association. Current certification in Basic Life Support (BLS), Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) and Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) granted by an approved American Heart Association program. Minimum three (3) years emergency, critical care or trauma experience. Minimum two (2) years recent nursing experience in one of the following areas: pre-hospital nursing, emergency, critical care or trauma care. Knowledge of state Trauma Plan and the American College of Surgeons (ASC) Trauma Center criteria. Previous experience in education program development.
