Trauma Information Systems Coordinator

This newly designed full time position will be responsible for overseeing and managing all aspects of the Trauma Registry and other Trauma databases. This will include working with the Trauma Registrars in the day-to-day operations of trauma patient data entry and injury coding accuracy. This individual will work closely with the Trauma Program Manager to produce monthly reports for Trauma Service PI and clinical operations. There will be opportunities for ongoing education and career growth. The successful candidate must have a current Colorado Nursing license with experience working with a Trauma Registry and injury coding.

Trauma Registrar

This full time position will work with the Trauma Registry Team to review and abstract trauma patient charts and enter select data into the Trauma Registry. This is an ideal position for an experienced RN who desires a new challenge and wants to use their nursing experience in a non-clinical role. Previous trauma registry experience is desirable but Trauma Registrar training is available.
