



TRAUMA SURGERY FELLOWSHIP

The Department of Surgery at the University of South Carolina School of Medicine is seeking candidates for a one-year fellowship in Trauma Surgery.

The fellow will be actively involved in acute trauma evaluations and daily patient care. Rotations will be arranged in the Surgical ICU for critical care training. There will be a core reading curriculum, and participation in a research project will be expected.

Palmetto Health Richland Hospital is the only Level I Trauma Center in the Midlands of South Carolina. There are approximately 2000 trauma admissions per year, 80% resulting from blunt trauma.

The USC Department of Surgery and Palmetto Health Richland Hospital are located in historic Columbia, South Carolina. The city is home to the University of South Carolina and Gamecock football, Fort Jackson (the Army's largest training base), and numerous cultural and recreational opportunities.
