The Division of Trauma/Critical Care within the Department of Surgery at the Medical College of Wisconsin in Milwaukee Wisconsin is seeking one general surgeon who is fellowship trained in surgical critical care and trauma or has already has added qualification in surgical critical care. We currently have 6 full-time surgeons in the Division and see a 7th because of increasing clinical and research loads. We provide all surgical coverage for our emergency department including injury and acute surgical problems. All faculty have the opportunity to do general surgery as well as staff the trauma and critical care services.

Our primary hospital is Froedtert Memorial Lutheran Hospital which is a Level I trauma center. We have an approved fellowship in critical care and a clinical trauma fellowship. Our trauma and critical care services are multidisciplinary with emergency medicine, orthopedic, and anesthesia residents. All faculty rotate on both services throughout the year with every third month being off of direct service duties. Our educational program has been rated the best in our Department by residents and students.

We are seeking an additional young surgeon who is interested in a career in academic surgery with a trauma/critical care emphasis. Academic rank will be consistent with experience although all fellowship trained individuals are started as an Assistant Professor. Salary is tied to training and experience using local and national benchmarks. Start date is expected to be no later than July 1, 2002.
