Mount Carmel West is a verified Level II trauma center, certified chest pain center, certified primary stroke center and certified bariatric center. The hospital is a comprehensive 362 bed tertiary care facility providing exceptional care to the residents of Columbus and the Central Ohio communities. Mount Carmel West is a teaching hospital with dynamic physician residency programs as well as an on site College of Nursing. The hospital is located in an urban setting near downtown.

The qualified candidate is responsible for the management of clinical practice, education, quality improvement, and system coordination. The Trauma Services Clinical Manager ensures compliance with regulatory requirements for trauma center operations and serves as hospital liaison to regional and state trauma systems.

The trauma program has been verified by the American College of Surgeons since 2001. The program has grown exponentially since its inception with current volumes nearing 1300 patients. The program is led by a trauma surgery and critical care fellowship trained Trauma Medical Director in conjunction with an Associate Orthopedic Medical Director, also trauma fellowship trained. The trauma program is supported by two trauma registrars, a trauma clinical analyst, an injury prevention specialist and a dedicated trauma social worker. Mount Carmel West is staffed by attending subspecialists to provide multidisciplinary care and is supported by the general surgery and orthopedic surgery residents.

Mount Carmel West is a part of the Mount Carmel Health System and a member of Trinity Health. As a Catholic organization, we are committed to our guiding behaviors of respect, compassion, excellence and care of the poor and underserved and social justice.
